Manitoba based scholarships:

<u>Alf Barnett Scholarship</u> – awarded to a RPN enrolled in a Masters or Doctoral program.

<u>John Kellie Scholarship</u> – awarded to a 3rd year student in the baccalaureate program at Brandon University with a minimum GPA of 3.0

<u>Kay Armstrong Scholarship</u> - awarded to a 4th year student in the baccalaureate program at Brandon University, with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

<u>Marlene Fitzsimmons Scholarship</u> – awarded to a RPN presenting a paper at a conference or enrolled in a certificate program. (may be applied for at any time during the year)

National Scholarships:

<u>John Alex Crawford Scholarship</u> – awarded to a RPN in Canada enrolled in a Masters or Doctoral program.

<u>Annette Thorimbert Osted Scholarship</u> – awarded to a 3rd or 4th year student enrolled in a baccalaureate program in psychiatric nursing in Canada, with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

McCormick/Henry Scholarship: awarded to a RPN in Canada who is taking further studies in seniors' mental health at the graduate level (MA or PhD) or through an accredited certificate program. (New in 2016).

RPNF Annual General Meeting and RPNF Awards Reception



The Annual General Meeting of the Registered Psychiatric Nurses Foundation Inc. was held in conjunction with the AGM of the College of Registered Psychiatric Nurses of Manitoba on **Thursday**, **May 12, 2016** at the Norwood Hotel, Winnipeg, Manitoba. There were 8 members of the board with additional

guests in attendance. Minutes of the 2015 RPNF annual general meeting were circulated for review and adopted; the 2016 President's Report to the Annual General Meeting was received; and the audited financial statements of the Registered Psychiatric Nurses' Foundation Inc. for the year ending December 31, 2015 be approved. Dean R. Jenkins, Chartered Accountant was appointed as auditor for the 2016 financial year.

The RPNF Fundraising Reception and Awards of Excellence followed the Annual General Meeting.

About the RPNF SCHOLARSHIPS

The Registered Psychiatric Nurses Foundation Inc. provides annual scholarships to support excellence in the field of psychiatric nursing.

The awards are limited to Registered Psychiatric Nurses and students preparing to become Registered Psychiatric Nurses in an approved undergraduate psychiatric nursing education program.

- 3 scholarships are currently available nationally;
- 4 provincial scholarships are available within Manitoba;
- 3 are undergrad scholarships;
- 3 are available to RPNs who are pursuing a Masters or PhD;
- 2 may be used by RPNs for continued certificate studies;
- 1 is for continuing studies in the area of Seniors Mental Health;
- 1 can be used to support an RPN who has presented at a conference.

The awarding of these scholarships is based on the academic and scholarly

work of the applicant (financial need is not a consideration). The RPNF is concerned with academic excellence in both undergraduate studies in an approved psychiatric nursing education program, and with psychiatric nursing education at the masters and doctoral levels.

The Registered Psychiatric Nurses' Foundation Inc. is able to provide these scholarships through the generosity of many donors and the sound investments of the board of directors managed through a permanent endowment fund. The sustainability of these scholarships will only be possible through continued donations.

The scholarship committee processes, selects and recommends the awarding of scholarships to the Board of Directors of the Foundation.

Applications will only be accepted when sent electronically.

Applicant Responsibilities

Application must be accompanied by Official Transcripts and Letters.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the application is submitted prior to January 15, 2017 with the appropriate documentation. Late, inadequately documented, or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Foundation's Responsibilities

Applicants will be notified of results no later than March 15/17. (Marlene Fitzsimmons scholarship will be notified by July 1st.)

There is no appeal process. All information is treated as confidential.

Financial awards will be accompanied by a T4A slip and all documentation related to the application will be retained by the Foundation for six years.

CRPNM versus RPNF What is the difference???



The College of Registered Psychiatric Nurses of Manitoba (CRPNM) is the regulatory body for the psychiatric nursing profession in Manitoba. The **CRPNM** is mandated, by the Registered Psychiatric Nurses Act, to **carry** out its activities and govern its members in a manner that serves and **protects the public interest.** RPNs pay an annual registration fee to cover the costs of administering this self-regulating Act.









The **Registered Psychiatric Nurses Foundation Inc.** (RPNF) is a totally separate organization from the CRPNM. It is incorporated under the Manitoba Corporations Act and has its charitable status from the Canada Revenue Agency. The RPNF's mission is to promote excellence in psychiatric nursing education, clinical practice, leadership and research.

The **RPNF** does this by attracting and managing gifts from donors into a permanent endowment fund. The return on investments are used to administer and provide annual scholarships. Seven scholarships are awarded annually to Registered Psychiatric Nurses and to students enrolled in a baccalaureate program in psychiatric nursing in Manitoba and across Canada.

The RPNF now also provides annual Awards of Excellence in Psychiatric **Nursing** to recognize excellence in Psychiatric Nursing practice, in the domains of Clinical, Education, Leadership and Administration and Research. This provides an opportunity to recognize and promote RPNs in Manitoba who have demonstrated exceptional professional behaviours and practices. The activities of the Foundation promoting RPNs and psychiatric nursing students support the RPNF's vision "to enhance the profession of psychiatric nursing in Canada."

Donations to the RPNF are tax deductible and contribute to an "enduring fund in perpetuity", which will secure the Foundation's future as well as continue to fund the Scholarships and Awards of Excellence.

RPNs, CRPNM, RPNF, and the Regulated Health **Professions Act**

Regulated Health Professions Act is the legal framework under which all regulated health professions in Manitoba including Registered Psychiatric Nurses will be governed. The Act has streamlined many processes across the 22 regulated health professions, including the complaints, investigation and discipline process.
